### **Reporting to the University**

EOA is responsible for overseeing compliance with civil rights and affirmative action laws, regulations, and policies as the Title IX and ADA coordinating office. EOA responds in a prompt and equitable manner to reports of sexual misconduct, discrimination, harassment, bullying, and retaliation.

EOA is able to provide referrals to resources, consultation, informal resolution options, and, when appropriate, investigation of potential policy violations.

Reporting to EOA may initiate an investigation under the Code of Student Conduct and/or applicable OSU Policy. EOA does not share information with law enforcement, except as required to report concerns of child abuse/neglect, immediate safety concerns on campus, or threats of harm to individuals.

### **Reporting to OSU Public Safety**

Provides 24/7 emergency response, nonemergency consultation, and recommendations for safety. DPS includes police officers and public safety personnel. Contact for on-campus safety concerns and to report an on-campus crime.
